Thank you for your willingness to write a recommendation letter for one of our Veterinary Cannabis Counselor (VCC) applicants.

The role of a VCC is to support you and your clinic team in the rapidly developing veterinary cannabis industry. VCCs receive training in utilizing their medical background as veterinary technicians to create a cannabis administration plan that is safe for the animal, maximizes medicinal potential, and most important, is complementary to your ongoing treatment protocols and recommendations. VCCs can provide pet parents with accurate veterinary information while keeping the veterinary team fully informed of all changes in that pet's medical treatment.

With rapid shifts of the legal status of cannabis, the myriad of available products and the inundation of our community by marketing & brand advertising, the VCC is trained to:

- Provide pet parents with harm reduction education about cannabis
- Evaluate and provide advice on safe cannabis products
- Keep the veterinary team informed about the pet parent's goals, the patient's home environment, and cannabis products the animal is receiving
- When appropriate, create a cannabis administration plan that supports the veterinarian's treatment protocols and encourage appropriate monitoring through the veterinary clinic

The requirements for acceptance into the VCC certification program are as follows:

1. Age: 21 years or older at the start of class
2. Education & Experience a. Certified Veterinary Technician with at least 2 years clinical experience OR b. On-the-Job Trained Veterinary Technician with at least 5 years clinical experience
3. Signed recommendation letters from 2 veterinarians
